These sessions are **unique** and give you the opportunity to understand how the skills I teach work on an **already trained** horse / pony. So you can concentrate on learning what **you** need to learn, before you go and approach other horses.



This is now available to be booked for 1 or up to 5 people at the time. Time spent will vary between 2 and 3 hours a session.



Brief overview of Course Content:

- How do horses learn?
- What do horses need us to do or to stop doing to be able to understand what we want them to do?
- Tools and how to communicate with them.
- How to be a good leader from a horses point of view.
- How to stay safe around horses.
- How to build a strong partnership with horses.
- First steps to learn how to assert leadership with horses on the ground.

This course is for anyone interested in horses. It does not matter how long you have been around horses, as the things I teach are not commonly taught in conventional horse riding establishments. You will start to see and understand things from the horses point of view, which will explain a multitude of problems you may have encountered along the way in the past.

If you are new to horses this will start you off on the right foot!



Do you wish you had a great relationship with your horse or simply just feel the need to improve the relationship you currently have with your horse? This is the course for you!

Total cost for 6 sessions is <u>£420.</u>

(all sessions will have to be taken within a 3 month period or earlier)

My courses are very personal and I spend a lot of time with each individual. Course size is therefore limited at present to a maximum of 5 people.

<u>Please Note:</u> To take part, appropriate footwear must be worn (e.g. trainers or hiking boots, no open toe shoes!) sensible, warm and / or weatherproof clothing are required depending on



weather conditions and a liability disclaimer form must be signed.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The final confirmed dates will be weather sensitive due to the venue being outdoors. Although, some bad weather will be acceptable, sometimes it is necessary to postpone due to exceedingly bad weather conditions / or a change of venue if appropriate. To prepare for such eventualities two additional dates will be fixed **in advance** to be kept free for this reason.

Due to the restricted number of people on the course it is advisable to book early to avoid disappointment.
